

## Talking Points: Conservatives Who Don't Expect To Vote

*Situation: Conservative voter. May have supported Ron Paul, Rick Santorum, etc. Ideologically opposed to Romney. Doesn't intend to vote.*

**Objection:** Romney's no different from Obama...

*Question: I hear your concerns. Which of these do you think would be better for America's future: a *first-term* Romney-Ryan Administration, or a *second-term* Obama-Biden Administration, where the President "will have more leeway"?*

*and/or*

*Question: Do you feel appointments to the **Supreme Court** will have an important influence on our future? Doesn't it matter **who** gets to name these justices? Does a president's philosophical orientation toward Islamic Sharia Law matter in these appointments?*

*and/or*

*Question: Do you feel American can withstand 4 more years of an unfettered, **lame-duck** president? Wouldn't there be great value just in disrupting all the executive orders, czars and policies of Obama?*

*and/or*

*Question: If we vote for an alternative candidate [*or, don't vote at all*], taking votes away from Romney, doesn't Obama win? How does that help America? Would it not be better to vote Romney, and then continue the fight [for conservative policies]? [if Obama is re-elected, will you even *get* another chance in four more years?]*
